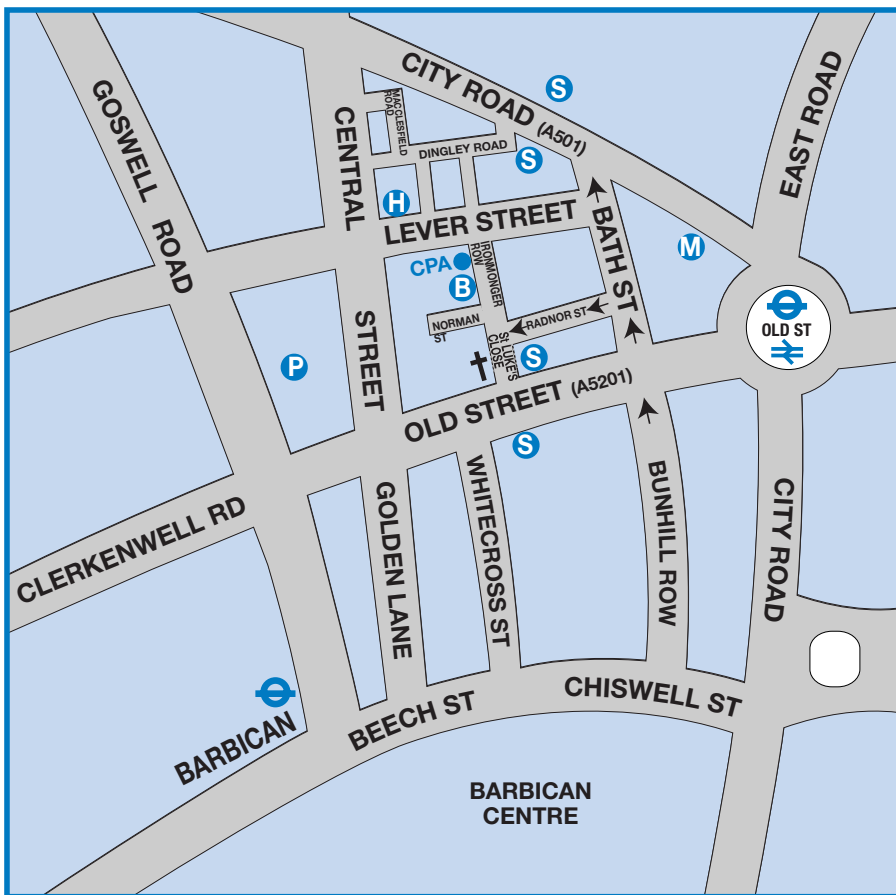

Ironmonger Row is closed to traffic at the Old Street/St Luke’s Close end, there is access for pedestrians only. The spire of St Luke’s church is the area landmark.

To walk from Old Street station, take exit 7 and continue along Old Street until you see the spire of St Luke’s church (4 mins). Just before the church turn right into St Luke’s Close, continue along through the pedestrianised area of Ironmonger Row, past a park on the left and back onto the road section. Pass Ironmonger Row Baths on the left and CPA library and offices are three doors down. It’s a 10 minute walk in total.

Parking in the area is restricted to meters, 2 and 4 hours, located in surrounding roads. Traffic wardens patrol regularly. The nearest NCP car park is in Pear Tree Street. Radnor Street is one way from Bath Street, there is no entry by car from Ironmonger Row. Norman Street is a cul de sac. Whitecross Street is closed to traffic for the daily street market, Bath Street is one way from Old Street.

Buses 55 and 243 stop along Old Street. Buses 43, 205, 214 and 394 stop along City Road.
